



EXHIBITOR PLAN

Make sure your booth is set up to accomplish your show goals! The booth should be fun and inviting so people want to stop and see your products. For ideas and/or help, please contact your account representative and supply us with a booth proposal.

GETTING TO THE SHOW

PAYMENT DETAILS

Payment for Booth Contract must be paid in full four (4) weeks prior to the show date. Payments can be made by visiting www.ruffrydersallstarweekend.com and accessing the links

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

In the event that you may need to cancel your Booth Contract, a written request MUST be made to Ruff Ryders Texas.

MUSIC/GIVEAWAYS

Music in your booth cannot exceed 85 dB. Measured from any adjacent isle or booth. Giveaways ARE allowed but cannot be thrown out to the crowd. They must be passed out in a hand to hand manor, or just simply left on a table or kiosk. Exhibitors will be issued one warning to reduce the sound prior to having the power disconnected.



CARS IN YOUR BOOTH

Fuel requirements vary for each venue. If you will have a car in your booth, please make sure you read the fuel requirements, found on our website under "Vendor Info" or at www.ruffrydersallstarweekend.com

Cars (and your booth contents) must stay within the booth footprint and cannot stick into the aisles. General rule of thumb is one (1) car fits into a 10'x20' with no display; for a car and small display, 10'x20'; for a car and good-size display, 20'x20' minimum.

Cars must roll in between 2pm. and 8 p.m. on the day prior to the show.

All vehicles must have the gas cap taped off and the battery must be disconnected. We will be strict on this due to fire codes. Please have hoods open and batteries disconnected by 7 p.m. on the day immediately prior to the show for inspection. Failure to comply will result in removal from the show.

ADMISSIBLE DISPLAYS

Displays that are of a disruptive, objectionable or inappropriate nature—as interpreted by show management—will be removed from the show. This also applies if your vehicle is blocking aisle traffic. Additionally,

- A.) Full display must be requested prior to the event date.
- B.) Show space is determined by show management. For special layouts, placements will be at the full discretion of show management staff.
- C.) All classes must have at least six (6) registered entries to compete for cash or prize. One vehicle is only eligible to compete in two (2) categories.



AMENDMENTS

- A.) The show management shall have the full power in the interpretation and enforcement of all terms, rules and regulations, and any further stipulations considered necessary for the proper conduct of the show.
- B.) Participants agree to comply with all standards and rules set forth by the judges and organizers of Ruff Ryders Texas All Star Car/bike show and partners. Participant's failure to comply with such terms, rules and regulations shall entitle Ruff Ryders Texas and its partners to terminate its obligations under this contract.
- C.) Participants agree to accept, under reasonable conditions, the final judgment and award of prizes of the judges of same event.
- D.) Participants agree to comply with all pertinent laws, codes and regulations of municipal or other authorities which affect the display space.

MODELS

All models in your display space must be in good taste. RRASCBS has many minors in attendance, and we need to make sure everything at the show is appropriate for all ages. No lingerie, extremely skimpy clothing and **absolutely** no stripping or lewd acts. Also, if a model in your booth becomes disruptive to the show, management reserves the right to stop any activities.

FOOD & DRINKS

There will be no outside food or beverages allowed inside the venue.



DISPLAY SPACE

All display vehicles, displays, signs, stickers etc. Must remain within your assigned show space at all times. Participants will be responsible for removal of all stickers left in the venue. If the expo center has to remove your stickers, the participant will be charged a fee for each sticker that has to be removed. No distribution of literature or placement of literature around the venue will be permitted (literature in your within your display is fine). **Any music must remain within the confines of your space or played at a level not to interrupt the business of surrounding vendors.**

CONDUCT & ATTIRE

All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a civilized, non-violent manner. Violence of any kind will not be tolerated. Those responsible for insinuating or participating, either physically or verbally, will be removed from show grounds and escorted off the premises. Violent action will not be tolerated. Law enforcement officials will be prosecuting to the full extent of the law. Weapons of any kind will also not be admitted into show grounds. Any and all weapons confiscated by security or event staff will not be returned to the individual(s), so do not bring them. A dress code will also be enforced during the event. No gang attire will be allowed. DUB Publishing, Inc. Reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.



Vehicle Roll In- ALL INDOORS

Vehicle Roll In Feb 12th 2010 from 3pm-9pm. You will form a line in rear of building by loading dock.

Fuel & Car Requirements

Indoors--All vehicles must have ¼ of a tank or less. Gas caps must be taped. Battery cables must be disconnected. Hoods must be open and ready for inspection @ 7:30pm. NO EXCEPTIONS!
Battery Chargers and converters are allowed. If you have a battery for audio systems, that battery does not need to be disconnected. If a vehicle is turned on while show is on. You will be asked to leave. This is for the safety of you and our patrons. Electricity may be purchased in advance for a lesser fee than the day of.

Spacing

Each vehicle is allotted a 10'x20' space or more. No sponsor banners are allowed. You may setup a display according to the venue rules and regulations.

Display Vehicles Vehicles going in sponsor/vendor booths must load in Friday February 12, 2010 between (12-6pm)

Music Acts

All acts must turn in all tracks in the order it should be played to the DJ at 10am Sat Feb. 13th. All acts must be at the stage 10 min prior to show time.

Acts must perform in their allotted time slot. If an act is not present at the performance time your show time will be filled in and you may not get a second chance to perform.

Booth must adhere to the sound regulations of the building and show management.



Registrant agreement

I agree to abide by all guidelines and rules set by the organization, judges and governing bodies.
